Exam Results - GCSE's

I am very pleased to inform you that once again we have seen a dramatic improvement in our results. We are again one of the most improved schools in the whole country. 87% of our students achieved 5A* to C at GCSE and 59% achieved 5A* to C including English and Maths.

Exam Results - A level.

Congratulations to our sixth form who achieved the top grades again this year - 100% pass rate at A2 putting Broadway 6th form in the top 10% of sixth form providers in the whole country.

Uniform
