Ramadan/Exam Results

I hope that you have had a good summer break. In order to support our students and the wider community, during the holy month of Ramadan, we will start school at 9.10am on both campuses from Wednesday 9 September and resume to our normal start time of 8.40am on Tuesday 22 September 2009. The times of the school bell at the end of the day will not change.

We have had a very busy summer preparing the school for your children as part of the Building Schools for the Future Project.

Congratulations to all the students who sat exams this summer. I am pleased to say that we have made excellent progress. Sixty percent of all our Y11 students achieved 5 GCSEs at grade 'C' or above – a massive 17% increase on last year. There was also a great improvement in Maths and English with 36% of all our Year 11s achieving 5 GCSEs at grade 'C' or above including Maths and English.

Our 'A' level students achieved very good results with 91% obtaining a grade A to E which is an 8% increase on last year.

However, we do need to improve on our previous best and in order to do so, students must follow these simple guidelines:

1. Attend school as often as possible – good attendance=good results
2. Come to school prepared to learn, with correct uniform and equipment
3. Complete all work set by staff by the given deadline
4. Come with a positive attitude, do as you are told first time, enjoy your time at Broadway School and do not miss an opportunity!
